2. E&A Officials Seminar 2nd-3rd April

The World Rulebook 2022 will be published at the end of February with the rules then taking effect 60 days later.

It was suggested that parts of the exam content should be updated to coincide with the new World Rulebook that comes into effect at the end of April.

4. Additional Rules
