2. Revised Eligibility Rules for 2020/2021 E&A Waterski Championships

Modifications to the Eligibility Rules for the 2020/2021 Titled events were discussed and approved.

3. Distribution of Panels

There have been requests from officials wishing to know the panel selections for the upcoming championships. They will be posted on the website and an email sent to all officials. Selected officials will be asked to go on EMS to accept the invitation to officiate.

4. Courses for Asian and Latin American Officials

Following clarification from Paul Fong, the request is that E&A WSC run a weekend webinar similar to the one we already run for E&A Officials including an exam session. They are prepared to pay a fee for the service.

It was agreed we could do this albeit it would have to be done in smaller chunks and not all in one weekend.

5. Capture Cards

An email has been sent to Homologators telling them that video capture cards are available for use with End-Course monitoring to enable the use of BPMS without the cost of a GPS system.

It was decided to wait and see the level of demand before deciding how to allocate the available supply.

6. Conflicts of Interest

Admincom has approved a new Conflict of Interest Rule which incorporates some suggestions made by WSC members.

7. Ongoing Disciplinary Process

There was great disappointment that there is still no decision from the Appeal Committee. It was agreed to write once again and ask for clarification on what might be causing the delay.

8. Boat Homologation

A date for retesting the boat has still not been confirmed.

9. Pro Tour Sub Committee

Candido updated the meeting on the ongoing discussions of the Pro Tour at World level. It was progressing well and the contract was largely agreed.
