The meeting commenced at 19:00 CET.

2. World, FISU, E&A Titled and RC Competitions

An application email will be sent to all level 1 officials regarding the upcoming +35 World Championships to be held in Baurech, France 12th-18th September. All applications should be received by 28.02.2022 as Nominations will take place on 1st March. An application email will also be sent regarding the FISU Championships to be held in Minsk, Belarus 24th-28th August. For all other E&A Titled and RC Tournaments, officials need to apply using EMS and should apply no later than 19th March.

A comment was made that the FISU Championships should maybe have a reduced judging panel for this year and maybe all future FISU Championships. In 2016 there were 10 judges appointed, 2 were unable to attend. Even with 2 judges missing, it was still felt that the remaining 8 judges were not really necessary.

3. Pro Tour Competitions

There will be a zoom meeting that will take place Calendar week 7 with all the Pro Tour organisers.

4. Athlete Representative

It was agreed that the AAC in IWWF World Council, Martin Kolman, should be invited to attend future E&A Council Meetings.

5. Exams

There have been requests from several Federations for their officials to take exams. Donal will pass on his knowledge and talent so that the exam online platform can continue as before.

6. Zero Off Presentation

Will Bush and Freddy Krueger have been gathering new data over the past season regarding some problems with "out of tolerance" times at Junior Championships. U17 Jump Time Tolerances at 51km were discussed. Will Bush and Freddie Krueger are to make a presentation to the WSC to determine if any changes are necessary.

5. Any other business

It was agreed that we only use the WSC email addresses for future correspondence.

A Chief Judge presentation is being prepared for the upcoming seminar. It was also suggested that a similar presentation should be prepared for Chief Scorer.

The Seminar in 2022 will take place online from 2nd-3rd April. The Seminar for 2023 will be at the Radisson Blu Hotel at Stansted Airport, London on 24th-26th March.

All entries to Titled events will be through EMS, but entry fees will, for this year, be paid separately as detailed in the Competition Bulletins. The World Rules have been amended to reflect this. We are waiting for an official statement on this matter.

Deadlines for ITE's, Bulletins, Entry forms will now be determined.
