2. Fines for late entry at Titled Events

Due to technical issues using EMS for entering skiers for titled events, it was decided to abstain from applying fines for late entries. This only applies presently for the 60 day deadline. Fines for the 30 day deadline will still be imposed.

3. Exams

The first series of exams using the exam platform have now been completed. The respective officials can expect their results shortly or have already been notified.

4. E&A Youth Official Familiarisation 2022

The 2 days reserved for E&A Youth Official Familiarisation will this year not accommodate the amount of skiers requiring Official Familiarisation. A solution to accommodate the amount of skiers entered for the E&A Youth 2022 is being found and will be published shortly.

5. Panels for Titled Events

The Panel for the 2022 IWWF E&A Open to be held in Recetto, Italy from 8th to 11th September was decided.

There are still officials missing for the following Championships:

2022 IWWF E&A +35 Championships - Iannina (GRE) - 20-24 July

2022 IWWF E&A Youth Championships - Iannina (GRE) - 02-07 August

2022 IWWF E&A Open Championships - Recetto (ITA) - 08-11 September

An email has already been circulated to all officials regarding the incomplete Panels.

6. Requests from Federations

3 requests received by the Waterski Council from National Federations were discussed. The respective Federations will now be informed of the Councils decision on these requests.

7. Miscellaneous

Although EMS is now in use for Titled Events, the anti-doping declaration must still be signed before the athlete can ski including the 35+ even if there will be no testing at that event.

There are some current issues and situations that have recently occurred on an IWWF Level that were then discussed.
