Meeting started with a welcome from Patrice.

- Monaco Congress meeting, will now be a virtual meeting.
- Voting Powers need to be sent in by 23rd December
- IHOF Representative. Gill asked for our nomination asap
- Went through Sid's requirements list, only query was around the dates for medals, asked if we could request them as late as possible, just to don't print anything incorrectly – just asked for latest lead time required.
- ADMINCOM Left the meeting, council continued on a new zoom call.
- IHOF after detailed council discussion, it was decided that Lucien Gerkau would be the best person to represent CWB, and that he would work closely with Carole Marmonier, who would potentially take over when Lucien was required to stand down.
- Rider of the Decade nominations, it was agreed that the riders of the year should be Lior sofer and Julia Rick. Due to the sheer number of World Championships that they had both won during the last decade, and also the domination of the ranking over the time. Both have won 3 World Championships events.

2014: Lior – 1st Open Men
Julia – 2nd Open Ladies
2016: Lior – 1st Open Men

2019: Lior – 1st Open Men
Julia – 1st Open Ladies

- Virtual Youth Festival – Suzi asked council members to send through entries for the UTS Festival asap, so they can be registered by 10th November for comp starting on 20th.
